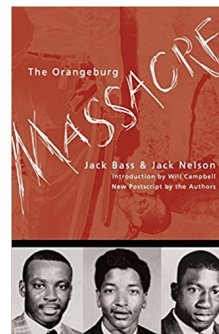
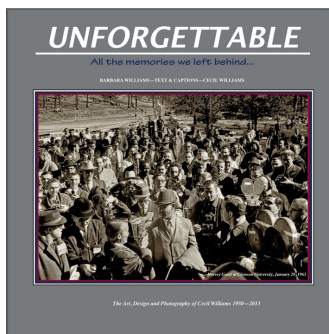
ST. GEORGE
